I agree to bear all expenses incurred should an injury/accident occur. I represent that I am in sound medical condition and have no physical or medical impairment which would endanger myself or others. Should I sustain injury which, in the opinion of the on-site emergency technicians, requires medical attention, I agree to said medical treatment. I further agree to wear an ANSI or Snell Certified helmet while riding on the tour. I will observe/obey all bike tour requirements, as well as Virginia traffic laws and regulations. I understand if I leave the route, I am no longer on the bike tour. I also give permission for use of my name and/or likeness in any newspaper, broadcast, telecast or other account of this event. Wherefore, as evidenced by my signature below, I waive, release, discharge for myself, my heirs, executors and administrators/legal representatives any and all rights and/or claims which I have, may have or may thereafter accrue to me against the sponsors and promoters or their agents, officers and employees for any and all claims which may be sustained by me.

The Annual **Rappahannock RoughRide** is a self-paced, multi-level cycling challenge for the recreational or serious cyclist, covering some of Virginia's most beautiful countryside. Courses range from 12, 35 and 60 miles over paved roads to a 20 or 30-mile paved and unpaved course.

The best part about this event is not only does it help get the word out about the services provided by the Fauquier Free Clinic, but your registration fee helps cover the expenses of this invaluable organization.

WHAT IS THE FAUQUIER FREE CLINIC?

The Fauquier Free Clinic is a volunteer organization which provides quality, primary health care and dental services to uninsured individuals and families living in Rappahannock and Fauquier Counties, with a special effort to include all children.

REGISTRATION INFORMATION:

Pre-registration - Adults \$25, Children under 12, \$15.00, family of four or more, \$60.00 by mail, postmarked no later than September 9, 2008. See registration form.

Tour-day registration - \$30 no later than 9:30 a.m. (**opens at 8:30 a.m.**) on the morning of the ride at the Trinity Episcopal Church.

DIRECTIONS FROM WARRENTON- Take US Route 211 West to Washington, Virginia. Use first exit to Washington. Trinity Episcopal Church is the first church on the left.

LOTS OF GREAT COURSES...

All courses start and end in Washington, Virginia, down the street from the world-famous Inn at Little Washington. Start time 10:00 a.m.

- ❖ **12-Mile Participation Ride:** This ride is designed for the casual rider and wends its way past lush farm land, apple orchards and the Jordan River. Refreshments at end of tour.
- ❖ **20 or 30-Mile Infamous RoughRide:** Designed for the rough and rugged, this is a course over paved and unpaved roads through some of Rappahannock's greatest scenery. Refreshments at end of 20-mile ride. One rest stop with refreshments on 30-mile ride.
- ❖ **35 or 60-Mile Road Tour:** Everyone will enjoy this route over paved roads, some quite hilly. One rest stop with refreshments on 35-mile tour, two on 60-mile course.

HELMETS ARE REQUIRED ON ALL RIDES. Participants under the age of 13 must be accompanied by a responsible adult if parent is not present.

THEN WHAT HAPPENS?

- The first 250 registered riders will receive the Rappahannock RoughRide T-shirt.
- Every cyclist who registers will be eligible to win one of several fabulous donated prizes. (Drawings will be held at 9:45 a.m.)
- Plan on spending the afternoon enjoying good ol' Rappahannock hospitality, restaurants and eateries, as well as unique village stores and antique shops in the historic town of Little Washington.
